**SHIELD FROM THE COLD** The weather outside isn't frightful just yet, but Vida Spa has put together a package of all-natural products to ward off the cold's effects. The Winter Essential Kit includes a Whipped Body Butter, a rich cream packed with cocoa butter and avocado oil to revitalize dry skin (\$14.85 for 60 ml); Hydrating Face Serum, a mix of rosehip oil, carrot oil, and evening primrose oil that comes in a bottle with a dropper and protects your face from biting wind (\$28 for 30 ml); Hand, Foot and Heel Cream, packed with shea butter and fresh-smelling with lavender, calendula, and tea-tree extracts (\$28 for 118 ml); and Nail Fuel, with jojoba and sweet almond oil to help brittle nails (\$16.50 for 25 ml). All are made locally by Vida under the Niche label. Did we mention the \$100 spa certificate? Go seasonal with the new Pine and Juniper Berry massage. Find the kit (valued at \$187 but selling for \$129) at the spa's local locations, in the Sheraton Vancouver Wall Centre Hotel (1088 Burrard Street) and Sutton Place Hotel (845 Burrard Street).
